Back in 1947, they say a UFO landed near Roswell, New Mexico and materials were recovered by the government. Over the years much debate has arisen from this incident and according to Wikipedia, "it ranks as one of the most publicized and controversial UFO incidents ever." To capitalize on this phenomenon and bring the story to life, Greg and Christine Payseno searched for a company that could create elements of this story for their new family entertainment center.

They were set on building a laser tag facility with a glow-in-the-dark miniature golf course. They spent months researching all the companies in the market but settled on Creative Works. "We wanted the WOW Effect, and after wading through all the companies out there, we knew that Creative Works was the only one that could make this happen for us," said Christine. "They were the clear choice after talking with the various companies, comparing their finished products and calling on their client lists. There was just something different about this company that made me feel secure in my decision."

Over the course of several weeks, the design team spent some late hours creating just the right look and feel for their laser tag and golf attractions. "We wanted to ensure some authenticity in their attractions and did some research to make sure their goals were met," said David Haas from the Design department. Of special interest was an alien clay model, fabricated by Doug Spencer, which was used for scanning and creating a 10 foot alien life-form out of foam

for the final hole in their golf attraction. Other unique pieces included alien egg-pods, giant turbine wall fans, high-tech archways and more in the golf and tag attractions.

In addition to attempting to create something unique for their town, Greg and Christine have had to overcome several hurdles in the process of opening their facility. They originally signed their contract in late 2006 and planned to open in 2007. A series of unfortunate events including leasing problems, zoning issues, theft of building supplies and more led to a nearly 2 year delay.



Throughout the process we encouraged them along the way, provided whatever services and information they needed, and held their hand to the finish. Jeff Schilling, owner of Creative Works, had these words to say, "Greg and Chris have faced more hurdles than any of our clients in the past 12 years. They were met with insurmountable odds, yet they stayed the course and remained faithful to the completion of their project. They are an inspiration to everyone out there trying to open a business. They've been through the trenches and have emerged with a determination unlike anything I've seen before. My hat is off to both of them for taking the steps necessary to see their dream become a reality."

"I just got back from Wazee's World." Christine commented. "Today is the first time I've been here since your installation team was finished with our site. I was blown away! It's absolutely amazing. It literally brought me to tears." She went on to say "I can't believe this
